I am writing to thank you and the T&W team for once again partnering with Traders Point to create spaces that allow us to expand our ministry in the greater Indianapolis area. T&W is a kingdom minded organization who “get churches” like us and the unique purpose behind why we were building and what we were trying to accomplish. You realize that it’s not just about building a building but more importantly, creating spaces that are welcoming for the ministry of bringing people into relationship with Jesus and one another.

Over the past year, your teams worked with us as we underwent not one but two new location renovations simultaneously. The project managers and superintendents as well as the architect, designers and sub-contractors you pulled together were professionals who respected our people, our vision and our budget. They seemed almost like one of us from the initial design charrette through design, budgeting, construction and turnover. You never came to us with a problem (and were several challenges in buildings that were 30+ and 100+ years old!) that you didn’t also have a possible solution – always thinking through what was best for us.

While not planned to be under construction with two projects simultaneously during 2016, a generous benefactor made the downtown location a reality sooner than we anticipated and the project was fast tracked to open in less than 6 months. The Neo-Classical Revival structure was completed in 1912 and had been well cared for during its one hundred years on North Delaware Street in the Old North Historical District. Once again the design build team that you pulled together responded in amazing fashion creating a plan that preserved and honored the original design of the building while allowing for technical and functional improvements needed for our ministry. Project Manager Bob Carrell and Superintendent Jake Dellinger not only proactively brought solutions for the biggest challenges to the smallest details, they did it with respect for our time line and consideration for our budget. The work they and your entire T&W team of designers and subcontractors put in on this project showed the pride they had in being a part of this undertaking. We couldn’t be more pleased with the results.

The hard work and commitment of your team and ours resulted in successful back-to-back weekend launches of our new North and Downtown locations. We are grateful for the major role T&W played in it. Thanks again to all of you!
